YES Program opens new office in Tooele

Tooele – YES (Youth Employability Services) will be holding an open house at their newly relocated Tooele office Wednesday, August 22, from 3-5 PM.

The YES office in Tooele is now located at 305 North Main Street, Suite 248 and is in the same building as the Department of Workforce Services. This gives the youth in the program a “one-stop-shop,” as Workforce Services provides the funds to pay many of the YES participants, said YES case manager Cheryl Leach.

The new office is a more convenient location and has more room to serve the clients, Leach said. YES has had an office in the Tooele area since 2000 and serves about 130 youth each year.

YES is a Salt Lake County Division of Youth Services program. It is a job training program for low-income youth ages 16 to 21 that are either in state custody or out of school.
